Chief Rob Simonds outlined the services that HES provides, including fire and rescue services, corporate trunked radio, emergency management and emergency medical services.

- ➤ Hamilton Emergency Services Fire Service profile; OMBI performance comparators; interim organizational structure; 2012 net operating budget; 2012 operating budget by cost category; 2012 major cost drivers
- ➤ Emergency Management and Corporate Trunked Radio Service profiles; organizational structure; 2012 net operating budget; 2012 operating budget by cost category; 2012 major cost drivers

Chief Simonds indicated that he would like to involve the Committee in an anatomy of a working incident/task analysis to demonstrate the roles of the various staff, in particular, when there is a serious situation, relative to their responsibilities, duties, monitoring, competencies.

Brent Browett, Emergency Medical Services/Paramedic Chief, provided a power point presentation which included Service profile; business model, emergency response plan, OMBI performance comparators (2010), performance indicators — historical demands and outcomes; patient surveys, organizational structure, 2012 net operating budget; 2012 operating budget by cost category; 2012 major cost drivers; 2012 base budget savings; Council-referred items and 2011-2012 EMS funding opportunities.

- Ascertain cost of feasibility study to begin the process of the City operating its own dispatch to achieve operational efficiencies and savings
