The General Issues Committee, at its November 14, 2011 meeting, considered the 2012 Tax Supported User Fee Report (FCS11096). The recommended Animal Control User Fees were referred to the Planning Committee for further discussion.

#### **ANALYSIS / RATIONALE FOR RECOMMENDATION**

(include Performance Measurement/Benchmarking Data, if applicable)

Appendix "A" to Report FCS11096 provided a listing of virtually all of the City's tax supported user fees, including those managed by the Animal Services Section of the Parking and By-Law Services Division. While the 50% discount on licences for seniors and the disabled was being maintained, there was confusion and concern because the recommended fee schedule attempted to continue the streamlining and simplification of the fee structure which began in 2011, and the HST status was being corrected for 2012.

As a result, staff are not proceeding with any further streamlining and simplification of the fee structure. Appendix "A" to this Report recommends Animal Control User Fees for 2012 which adhere to the Council approved guideline of 2.2% (with some minor deviation due to rounding up to the nearest dollar for all rates except those for seniors which are rounded down to the nearest dollar). No new fees are being proposed, and the 50% discount on licences and other reductions for seniors and the disabled are being maintained.
