6.1 Correspondence:

- Bike Share program City staff are exploring funding options for such a program
- Bike locker at City Hall the members asked for an update on this action for the May meeting.

6.3 Education

- Can-Bike the Can-Bike classes are now offered through the City Recreation Division.
- OPHA (Ontario Public Health Assoc.) this provincial organization is drafting a letter requesting increased cycling education in the province.
 OPHA will encourage other organizations to endorse this letter.
- Car magnets the magnets and the new product of stickers are expected to be ready soon for delivery to Hamilton bike shops.
- Share the Road 6-actions campaign the committee discussed details of the design of the materials and Daryl to arrange the design of materials as discussed.

6.4 Promotion

- Welcome Cyclists this provincial organization is developing province-wide cycling promotion and the City has a rep on the Welcome Cyclists Advisory Committee.
- Bike-to-Work Day is set for Monday, May 28, 2012
- HCyC info booth comments received at the Toronto International Bike Show were reviewed. Roger to check on details of the valet bike parking (security & set-up) planned for the Battlefield Reenactment in early June. The New Hope Bike Co-op in East Hamilton is organizing a bike festival, the HCyC has asked for more details.
- Website content of the new "cycling education" webpage was circulated.

6.6 Planning

- Members were reminded of the following studies: the Pedestrian Mobility Plan, Hwy 8 Greensville EA (Marc may attend the community meeting as Bob B cannot attend), Waterdown Rd, the Longwood Rd EA, and the ROPA9 EA in the Highland/Rymal area. It was suggested that the HCyC Chair should meet with Councillor Clark to discuss the plan for bike lanes on Highland Rd as planned in the cycling master plan.

6.7 Project Updates

- Bike racks the City will install more bike racks this spring/summer
- The plans for bike lanes on Victoria Avenue, Woodward Avenue, and Burlington St are proceeding for 2012 installation. The reconstruction

- of West 5th in 2012 is planned to have wider curb lanes and sharrows to make it safer and more comfortable for cyclists.
- The construction of the cycling facilities connecting Studholme Rd easterly to Glenside Ave and westerly to Longwood Rd is planned to be constructed this fall, as well as a connection on Longwood Rd northerly toward Main St.

6.8 Maintenance

- The winter maintenance pilot of bike lanes is set to conclude on April 9. After that date feedback from the on-line survey and ridership data will be analyzed.
