#### RECOMMENDATION

- (a) That the 2014 User Fees contained in Appendix "A" to Report FCS13079 "2014 Tax Supported User Fees" be approved and implemented;
- (b) That the City Solicitor & Corporate Counsel be authorized and directed to prepare all necessary by-laws, for Council approval, for the purposes of establishing the user fees contained within this report;
- (c) That, subject to the approval of the 2014 User Fees as contained in Appendix "A" to Report FCS13079 "2014 Tax Supported User Fees", By-law No. 02-284 "To Establish Fees for Fire Prevention and Suppression Services" be repealed as of December 31, 2013.

#### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Similar to prior years, the 2014 User Fees are being considered in advance of the main budget deliberations. This allows for a more predictable revenue flow for programs and better communications to program users (customers). For the most part, these proposed user fees will be effective January 1, 2014. Some fees, however, (e.g., Recreation program fees, User Group Ice Rates, Macassa day program fee), are effective sometime later in 2014.

Appendix "A" to report FCS13079 identifies virtually all of the City's tax supported user fees (including proposed new fees) with the following exceptions:

- Transit fares: going forward as part of the 2014 budget deliberations;
- Building Permit Fees: going forward with a separate report to the Planning Committee meeting in December, 2013;
- ◆ Planning and Growth Management fees: already have approval through By-law 12-282 "Tariff of Fees" to increase annually by inflation;
- ♦ Hall Rental rates (Recreation), although included in Appendix "A" to report FCS13079, are being recommended to be restructured through companion report "Recreation Facility Rental Fee Consolidation" (CS13039).

At the end of the budget process, all approved fees, whether through this report or separate reports, will be consolidated into one 2014 user fee by-law.

In June, 2013, City Council approved the following guideline with respect to user fees:

"That 2014 user fees (excluding golf, transit, ice rental fees and web transaction or convenience fees) be increased by a rate of 2.0% and that any user fee adjustments, other than this rate, include an appropriate explanation when submitted."

As stated in report FCS13048/CM13010 "2014 Tax Budget Guideline and Process", although a rate of 2.0% is higher than the current Ontario Consumer Price Index (CPI), it more accurately reflects the increasing cost of service for the City, as items such as labour costs (including collective agreements) and utility costs, increased at a rate above CPI.

As identified in Appendix "A" to report FCS13079, most user fees are generally increasing by this Council approved guideline of 2.0%. There are, however, some exceptions:

 Certain user fees are being recommended to remain unchanged, either due to a pending review or market/cost analysis indicating that the current fee is appropriate and an increase is not warranted.

- Conversely, some requested fee increases may exceed the guideline if costs to provide the service are increasing in excess of the guideline, or the above guideline increase is required to ensure full cost recovery.
- ♦ In some circumstances, particularly now with the elimination of the penny, it is desirable to round the total fee (including tax) to provide for added customer convenience and more efficient cash handling procedures. In these circumstances, depending on the rounding, increases to some user fees may be slightly higher or lower than the Council approved guideline.

User Fee increases which deviate from this guideline have a corresponding explanation under "Basis for Fee Increase" in Appendix "A" to report FCS13079.

This report also identifies any new fees which are being proposed, as well as fees which are being deleted. Details on these new/deleted fees are included in the "Analysis/Rationale for Recommendation" section of this report. Of particular note is a new Fire "All Response" fee being proposed (set at 100% cost recovery) that would only apply to unusual responses involving protracted extinguishment and or investigation requiring additional resources outside the current capabilities of the Hamilton Fire Department. More details on this new proposed fee is identified in page 7 of report FCS13079 "2014 Tax Supported User Fees".

#### FINANCIAL / STAFFING / LEGAL IMPLICATIONS (for Recommendation(s) only)

**Financial:** Approval of the user fees is an integral part of the annual budget process. Revenue estimates for the 2014 budget are based on the fees contained within this report. As identified in report FCS13062 "2014 Tax Budget Preliminary Outlook", this represents approximately \$1.6 million in additional revenues when compared to 2013.

#### **HISTORICAL BACKGROUND** (Chronology of events)

Each year, the City sets its user fees at the start of the budget process. For the most part, these user fees are effective January 1. The annual user fee by-law is then passed by Council at the completion of the budget process.

#### RELEVANT CONSULTATION

The user fees contained in Appendix "A" to report FCS13079 were submitted by the program departments. As the Fire Department's user fees are also contained in the annual City-wide User Fees and Charges By-law, By-law No. 02-284 "To Establish Fees for Fire Prevention and Suppression Services" is no longer necessary, and therefore should be repealed as of December 31, 2013.

#### ANALYSIS / RATIONALE FOR RECOMMENDATION

(include Performance Measurement/Benchmarking Data, if applicable)

As identified, Appendix "A" to report FCS13079 provides a listing of virtually all of the City's tax supported user fees. The following is an explanation by department:

<u>Planning & Economic Development</u> (pages 1 - 28 of Appendix "A" to report FCS13079):

For the most part, user fees within this department are increasing by the Council approved guideline, with some deviation as a result of ensuring that the total proposed fee is rounded. The exceptions include:

- Fees set at "100% cost recovery" may deviate from guideline, depending on costs to provide the service.
- In Urban Renewal, although the initial application fees for the incentive programs are proposed to increase by the Council approved guideline (rounded to the nearest \$5), the "per unit" fees are proposed to remain unchanged so as to not act as a disincentive.
- Lottery License Fees (with the exception of the application fee) are proposed to remain unchanged, either because they are set by the Province or the current fee is at the maximum allowable as per Provincial guidelines.
- Parking fees which are either set by the Province or have been set as per registered agreements are proposed to remain unchanged.
- Tourism-Oriented Directional Signs (TODS) and signs under the LOGO sign program are proposed to remain unchanged, as these fees are provincially mandated.

- Culture (pages 22 28):
  - Museum general admission fees for the "Family" category are increasing greater than the 2% guideline in order to maintain an appropriate discount level (i.e. the Family rate should be higher than 2 adults + 1 child, but lower than 2 adults + 2 children). This appropriate discount level was not maintained in 2013 and has therefore resulted in above-guideline increases for 2014. All other museum general admission fees (adult, senior, student/youth, child) are proposed to increase by the guideline, rounded to the nearest quarter. As these fees range between just \$2 to \$10, the \$0.25 increase (inclusive of HST), would result in increases above 2%. Staff are also recommending to postpone any increase in the general admission fee for the Fieldcote Memorial Park & Museum due to a reduction in some services/facilities resulting from a major exhibit change in 2014.
  - Museum Group Rates are also proposed to increase by \$0.25, in order to maintain the appropriate discount. Similar to the general admission fees, this results in increases above 2% due to the size of the fees (less than \$7).
  - Annual museum membership fees are proposed to remain unchanged for 2014 due to the negative feedback received as a result of the 2013 fee increase. For the most part, purchasers of the annual museum memberships are the museum volunteers.
  - Museum rental rates for social and corporate functions and use of grounds are proposed to increase slightly higher than the guideline to reflect rental rates at similar facilities in the regional market.
  - The commercial film rates above-guideline increase reflects film rates in similar facilities in the regional market. The 2014 proposed fees, however, are still below market. As such, a phased increase over the next several years is being proposed to eventually meet market rates.
- New fees proposed include:
  - Administration fees for the ERASE Grant Study and the ERASE Redevelopment Grant of \$200 and \$700 respective. These new fees are being introduced in order to be consistent with other financial incentive programs.
  - Room rental rates (Social and Corporate) and fees for Special Events at the Visitors Service Centre to match those charged at the museums.
  - Hamilton Film Office Permit Fees For Profit Productions \$25, Non-Profit Productions \$15. All student productions will be exempt from these permit fees.

 In September, 2013, Council approved the second year of the five-year cost recovery phase-in strategy for Business License Fees (PD01104(h)). The 2% guideline has been applied to these <u>updated</u> Business License fees.

**Public Health Services** (pages 29 - 30 of Appendix "A" to report FCS13079):

User fees are being proposed to increase by the guideline, with some deviation due to rounding to the nearest dollar (for easier cash handling).

<u>Community & Emergency Services</u> (pages 31 - 62 of Appendix "A" to report FCS13079):

For the most part, user fees within this department are increasing by the Council approved guideline, with some deviation as a result of ensuring that the total proposed fee is rounded. The exceptions include:

- Recreation fees (pages 37 62)
  - Registered Program fees (non-aquatic) staff continue to streamline/consolidate fees. A number of formatting adjustments have been made in which many fees have been renamed to provide simplicity and transparency for customers and staff. Program fees no longer in use have been removed. In an effort to gradually move towards fully harmonized registered program fees, an "all facilities" fee has been determined for most of these programs – fees higher than the equivalent "all facilities" fee are proposed to remain unchanged, while fees lower are proposed to increase by 3%. The proposed 2014 program fees will be effective March 1, 2014.
  - Hall Rental rates proposed to remain unchanged, subject to changes being recommended through staff report "Recreation Facility Rental Fee Consolidation" (CS13039).
  - User Group Ice Rates (page 62) are excluded from the 2% guideline. For the most part, these fees are increasing 2.9% to reflect market rates and potential to re-sell ice. An exception to this are the non-subsidized fees for the Mohawk 4-pad which are proposed to increase less than 1% due to market competition. Also, the Summer Ice Affiliated fee is increasing 21% in adherence to the 2-year phase-in plan, which results in this fee being equivalent to the Non-Prime Time fee in 2014. The proposed 2014 user fees for the user group ice rates will be effective August 1, 2014.
- Helping Hands Program fees are proposed to remain unchanged, due to the potential negative impact on the client group, which are low income seniors and disabled individuals. Note that these fees were increased for the first time since 2004 last year. This increase in 2013 was above the Council approved guideline.
- Macassa Lodge's Day Program fee is proposed to increase 2.9% to offset staffing costs in order to maintain the 4-year budget outlined by the Local Health

- Integrated Network (LHIN). This increased fee will not be effective until April 1, 2014.
- The Fire Department's fees for Motor Vehicle Response are remaining unchanged as they are set by the Ministry of Transportation.
- New fees proposed include:
  - Several new fees added in Recreation due to the addition of new courses being offered at specific facilities. New "all facilities" registered program fees have been added to consolidate the same fee being charged at several facilities.
  - Fire is proposing the introduction of an "All Response" fee set at 100% cost recovery. This fee will be applicable only if the Fire Department responds to a fire that, due to the nature of the fire, the Fire Chief (or Deputy Chief or Incident Commander as designated) determines that it is necessary to retain the services of a private contractor, engineer, rent specialized equipment or use consumable materials other than water to suppress or extinguish the fire, prevent the fire from spreading or for investigation purposes. The owner of the property would be charged for the additional expenses. The fee charged will be based on current rates at the time of the incident. The charges noted in the "All Response" would only apply to unusual responses involving protracted extinguishment and or investigation requiring additional resources outside the current capabilities of the Hamilton Fire Department. The basis of the charge is to ensure that the owner of the property, and not the City of Hamilton/Hamilton Fire Department, is responsible for the actual costs incurred that are above and beyond the ordinary costs to extinguish a fire, preserve property, investigation or eliminate a risk. Some examples include, but are not limited to, retaining a private contractor with heavy equipment such as an excavator to break up piles to allow quicker extinguishment of a fire or purchasing shoring lumber to stabilize surroundings for confined space rescue. Mississauga and Haldimand currently have a similar fee.
  - Events fee for non-emergency stand-by (i.e. film events, demolition derbies). This new fee has been established based on the existing fee of \$410 (per Fire vehicle, for the first hour) for Response for Motor Vehicles set by the MTO, plus 100% cost recovery for the Fire crew.
  - A new "Student Housing, Bed & Breakfast, Lodging House" category for (Fire) inspections of Residential buildings has been added. The fee for this new category is equivalent to the fee for inspection of foster care homes and group homes with a capacity of greater than four residents, as these were previously charged under the foster care home/group home category.

Note that since all of the Fire Department's user fees are included within the 2014 User fees contained in this report (and subsequently will be included in the forthcoming 2014 User Fees & Charges By-law), the recommendation is that Bylaw No. 02-284 "To Establish Fees for Fire Prevention and Suppression Services" be repealed.

**Public Works** (pages 63 - 77 of Appendix "A" to report FCS13079):

Similar to other departments, most of the Public Works' user fees are increasing by the Council approved guideline, with some deviation as a result of ensuring that the total proposed fee is rounded. The exceptions include:

- Fees set at "100% cost recovery" may deviate from guideline, depending on costs to provide the service.
- The Road Occupancy Permit fee and the per day fee for Arterial Lane Sidewalk Occupation (ALSO) are proposed to remain unchanged. Both these fees are relatively new and, as such, the current fee is sufficient.
- Fees for commemorative trees are proposed to remain unchanged, as the current fees achieve full cost recovery.
- Similar to 2013, the Tipping Fee per 100 kilograms and the Minimum Vehicle Fee is proposed to remain unchanged in adherence to the Solid Waste Management Master Plan.
- Deposit fees at the transfer stations are also proposed to remain unchanged, as no increase is required to these refundable deposits.
- Cemetery license fees and fees for Care & Maintenance are remaining unchanged, as they are prescribed by the Province under the Cemeteries Act.
- The fee for Temporary Road Access Permit Application and Security Deposit are proposed to remain unchanged, as no increase is required.
- Golf fees are excluded from the Council approved guideline. No change is proposed in the fees for 2014 due to market conditions and trends. Not increasing the fees will also help establish a competitive edge and hopefully result in an increase in memberships in the 2014 season.
- User fees for Tim Hortons Field are proposed to be established by the end of 2013. Staff are currently in process of polling the market to ensure new fees are aligned with 'like' facilities/stadiums.
- Similar to prior years, the fees for Urban Charters are being proposed to increase by 5% in an effort to bring these fees more in line with actual costs.
- HSR photo id charge is being proposed to remain unchanged as it's a minimal fee to recover the cost of the service.
- New fees proposed include:
  - New Publication Box Permit initial fee and annual renewal fee to cover the cost of reviewing, processing and administration of annual permit applications for publication boxes on the road allowance.

- Transit fares are going forward separately as part of the 2014 budget deliberations.
- With respect to the Child (Cemetery) fees 2013 was year 3 of the 3-year cycle. The guideline increase proposed in 2014 corresponds to a new 3-year cycle, whereby Year 1 (2014) is the year in which the increase occurs, then Year 2 (2015) and Year 3 (2016) there is no increase. The next increase is in 2017 when a new 3-year cycle starts again.

#### Corporate Services (pages 78 - 83 of Appendix "A" to report FCS13079):

User fees are proposed to increase by the Council guideline (with some deviation due to rounding), with the following exceptions:

- The Financial Services fees for "Consideration of Assignment / Corporate Change Requests" are increasing greater than the 2% Council approved guideline to ensure the 2014 proposed fee is more reflective of the costs incurred to execute such changes.
- As identified in staff report FCS13048/CM13010, the convenience fee for on-line transactions is being eliminated for 2014 in order to encourage greater use of online web services.

#### City Managers Office (page 84 of Appendix "A" to report FCS13079):

 Human Resources – Employee File Duplication fee is increasing by the Council approved guideline, rounded to the nearest nickel.
