



# ... what our successes mean to vulnerable citizens

- As a system we served 26,107 community meals, assisted 7,900 households and distributed 369,000 lbs. of emergency groceries to over 18,000 people in need during the month of March 2012.
- # of 2012 Christmas Hampers: 11,900 for more than 32,700 people, Approx. 40% of those were children
