Objection to Liquor License Application Konoba, 34 Hess Street South, Hamilton, Ontario L8P 3N1 – for Outdoor Area

Whereas, the City of Hamilton has received prenotification that Konoba at 34 Hess Street South, Hamilton has applied for a liquor license change to add a new Outdoor Area with an occupancy of 56;

And Whereas, under Section 7.1 (1) of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario's legislation, they shall consider a resolution of Council of the municipality, in which are located the premises for which a person makes an application to sell liquor or holds a license to sell liquor, as proof of the needs and wishes of the residents of the municipality for the purposes of clause 6 (2) (h) of the Act;

Therefore, be it resolved:

That the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) be advised that the City of Hamilton wishes to object to the Liquor License application for Konoba at 34 Hess Street South, Hamilton, Ontario, for the new Outdoor Area to allow the Durand Neighbourhood Association the opportunity to suggest conditions for the consideration of the AGCO on this application.
