On <u>November 8, 2011</u> I attended a planning meeting at the City of Hamilton. At the meeting I spoke concerning the request to have a cul de sac built to separate our residential area from the manufacturing facilities of the same street. The development of an Industrial Park was underway.

I had a signed petition from the residents residing between 580 Glover Road and 703 Glover Road. (up to Dickenson Rd). All residents very concerned about traffic and safety.

This request was unanimous at the time. Unfortunately a couple homeowners have changed their view. I believe only two homeowners of many homeowners. I have spoken to the majority of others who are still very much in favor of a cul de sac. We still have well over 90% in favor!!
