## Development of the Transit Only Lane Project (pilot)

#### **Past Actions**

- 2008: Funding was provided by Metrolinx for selected "Quick Wins" projects
- Summer 2012: all segments of the A-Line and B-Line corridors were analyzed to identify the preferred segment
- February 2013: Council endorsed the Transit Only Lane on King St in principal (Rapid Ready Report)


#### <u>Planned Actions</u>

- May 2013: Complete Stakeholder Communications
- June 2013: Finalize the Design
- June 2013: Begin Public Notices
- July/August 2013: Install the Transit Only Lanes
- September 2013: Conclude Public Notices
- Autumn 2014: Report Back to Council/PWC including Evaluation of Before & After Performance

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### **Operations & Impacts**

Transit: bus delays reduced

Pedestrians: minimal improvements

Autos: as per existing operations

Bicycles: encouraged to use parallel routes

Parking: comparable supply maintained on the south side

Loading: relocated from the north side to the south side

A new section in the Traffic Bylaw to formalize TOLs will be created.

We will work with HMPS to ensure on-street parking and loading areas.

Evaluation of existing operations is underway and evaluation is planned to be undertaken after the TOL is installed.

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










