10.1 Winter Control Program - Review of Service Level for Urban Residential Class Three Roadways (Snow plowing activation)

Whereas the current Winter Control Program (WCP) service level has been in existence since 2001 and its activation parameters for class three roadways do not distinguish between cross sections with or without pedestrian facilities, and;

Whereas recent provincial legislation and policy has placed more emphasis on enhancing active transportation including pedestrian activity within urban areas (i.e. AODA, Transportation Master Plan, Cycling Master Plan, International Charter for Walking, Pedestrian Mobility Plan, etc.)

Therefore staff be directed to review the plowing activation parameters within the WCP Service Level to identify opportunities to enhance active transportation opportunities including pedestrian activity on class three residential roadways within the urban area, which have been constructed without pedestrian facilities and report back with an incremental operating cost impact for the program activation protocol.
